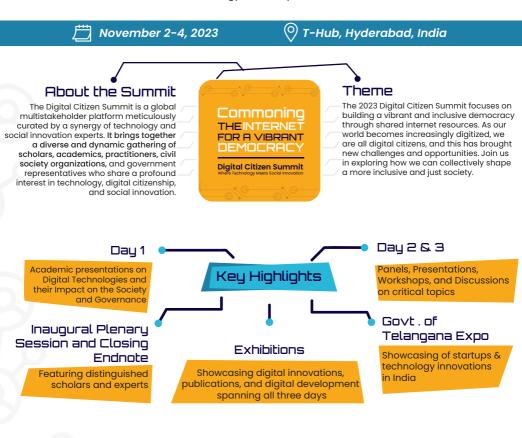






Welcome to the 5th Digital Citizen Summit 2023!
