The Three-day Conference has been divided into three days:

Day 1 (**November 2**) being an academic conference involving presentation of research scholars by 12 scholars and experts. These papers will cover a wide range of topics, from Data Ownership and Data Protection to AI Regulations, AI Dark Patterns, Digitization of the Indian Judiciary System, Platformized Unionism, and the challenges faced by Transgender people in the Digital Age and Minority Surveillance.

Day 2 (November 3) and Day 3 (November 4) are dedicated to 30 different workshops conducted by diverse organizations and experts in the field, taking place in four parallel sessions. On both the days of the Summit, we have eminent speakers comprising experts and scholars from the field of digital.

There will be an exhibition on Access to Rights and Rights to Access: The Story of Digital Development in India that will take us through 20 years of digital development in India and will include stalls from organizations participating in the Summit. This will be followed by a showcasing of digital and technological development through digital tools in India at T-Works and a showcasing of startups and technology innovations in India to foster an environment for scaling entrepreneurship and driving digital innovation at T-Hub and WE-Hub.
